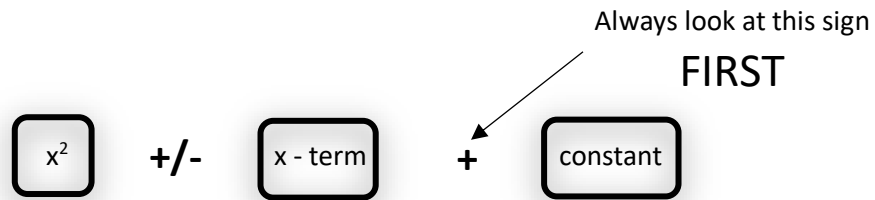

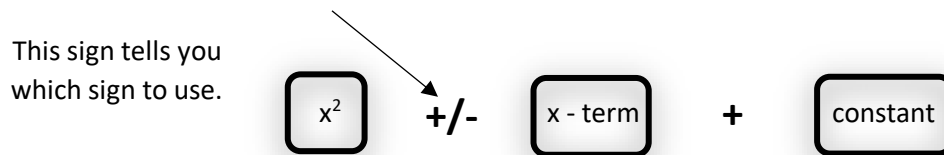

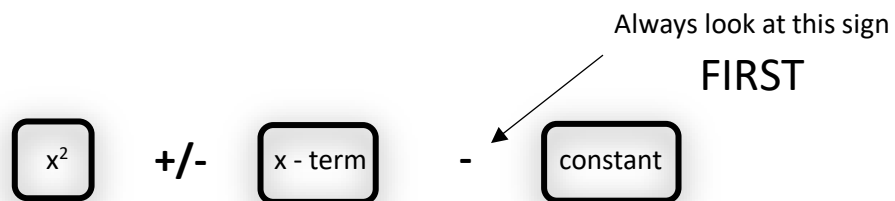
WHAT IT MEANS IF "+"

$$(+) (+) \quad \text{OR} \quad (-) (-)$$

HOW DO I DECIDE WHICH ONE TO USE?



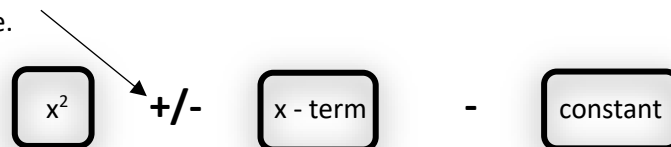
Numbers multiply to give you constant term but **ADD** to give you middle term.



WHAT IT MEANS IF "-"

$$(+) (-)$$

The larger factor goes with the sign that matches this one.



Numbers multiply to give you constant term but **SUBTRACT** to give you middle term.
